For BWCAW trips, all deposit fees held by Cliff Wold's over and above \$50 per camping group of 2 to 9 people will be promptly refunded by Cliff Wold's upon notice of cancellation postmarked two or more weeks before the trip was to have begun. For BWCAW trips, all deposit amounts over \$100 per camping group of 2 to 9 people, except \$50, will be refunded regardless of notification date. For Quetico Park trips, deposit refunds will vary depending upon the amount of the overnight camping fee deposit refunded to us by the Quetico Park. Make sure deposit fees are included with the reservation. Permit reservations, with either the BWCAW or Quetico Park officials, cannot be made without a deposit.

DEPOSITS.....\$100 deposit (\$50 non-refundable) payable to Cliff Wold's at the time of reservation: are, for each group of 2-9 people per trip to the BWCAW, \$68 pre-trip reservation costs, plus \$20 Forest Service Deposit, plus \$12 Forest Service permit reservation fee, for a total of \$100. To the Quetico Park, \$150 for each group of 2-9 people.

And they require that each leader and additional leader have in his possession an "Over-Night Travel Permit." Check our instructions for further information.
